


THREE QUICK TIPS

from the BEHS Library

TIP #1: At the BASIC SEARCH screen, pick:

Person - By or About	Name of Work	Keywords	Entire Document
TO	TO	TO	TO
find works written by your author or critical reviews about your author.	find critical reviews about a specific short story, novel, play or poem. Sometimes you can find the work itself too.	find information about themes, genres, literary movements and other broad topics.	do a really wide search. This choice searches the full-text of articles so will not be as focused as a keyword search.



Basic Search

Find :


Search for words in: Person - By or About Name of Work Keywords Entire Document

limit results:

to documents with full text

TIP #2: Limit your search to documents with full text if you don't want to see citations or abstracts.

TIP #3: When you see your search results, Use the **SUBJECTS** and the **TABS** to zoom in on your topic:
